

## Twin Consultation – Practical Informations

---

1) **Language:** The official language of the conference will be English.

2) **Program:** The complete program of the event is already available online on the site: [www.r-e-t.net](http://www.r-e-t.net). Upon registration you will receive the Conference Book which will contain detailed informations on the program. It is possible that changes could occur and we will seek to keep you informed about them, always counting on your understanding.

3) **Registration:** it is important that all participants register before the conference, so that your attendance may be confirmed and you have access to the material which will be important during the event. The registration will take place in the Francke Foundations, Franckeplatz 1 in the Faculty of Theology (House 30 on the Campus). Please look for the Conference signs.

4) **Access:** Halle is not a very big city (240 thousand inhabitants). Public Transportation is the best way to travel. Tram stations are close to the Francke Foundations as well as to the hotels. You will get detailed informations at the conference.

5) **Climate:** May in Germany can already be a warm time of the year (up to 25 °C), but also temperatures around 10 °C are possible. We suggest you may come prepared with light cloths but also have clothing for cooler weather and protection for rain.

6) **Security:** Germany is considered to be a safe place to travel. Anyhow we suggest, that you not walk alone at night. Be aware of the traffic. Pedestrian strips are generally respected by most drivers but not to be taken for granted. Traffic lights, including pedestrian traffic lights should be observed. In General please leave your luggage or belongings not unattended.

7) **Exchange:** You may change cash directly at the airport. Creditcards are accepted in most shops and cash machines.

9) **Outlets/plugs:** at the airports it is possible to find adaptors for the electric outlets. The electric current in Germany is 220V.
