- A lot of other materials (from workshops, liturgies etc.) have been uploaded on <http://www.globethics.net/web/reformation-education-transformation>.


We wish to express our high appreciation to all those who have contributed!

- The executive planning group has produced a draft version of the proceedings of the Halle conference, planned to be published in the German journal *epd Dokumentation* in October 2016.
- The executive planning group is working on a comprehensive publication of the entire twin-consultation process in English, comprising the key documents, a selection of complementary papers shared at the events, as well as salient results, recommendations and observations. We hope this publication to be finalized by the beginning of 2017 and to be made available for the Reformation Jubilee occasions in 2017.
